Beginning at the West corner of this lot, the North corner of Lot 16 and on the South side of Aiea Ridge Road, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Salt Lake" being: 10488.7 feet North and 1317.0 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2536, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 314° 09' 900.0 feet along Lot 16 to a point 10 feet from North edge of the North fork of the Aiea Stream passing over a stake at 705.0 feet;
2. Thence on a line parallel to and 10 feet from North edge of the North fork of the Aiea Stream, the direct azimuth and distance being: 210° 32' 318.9 feet to the South corner of Lot 12;
3. 134° 09' 825.0 feet along Lot 12 to a stake on the South side of Aiea Ridge Road passing over a stake at 250.0 feet;
4. 44° 09' 310.0 feet along South side of Aiea Ridge Road to the point of beginning.
