Beginning at a spike set in concrete at the Southeast corner of this lot, the Southwest corner of Lot 14, and on the North side of road (30 feet wide), the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kaneahuea" being 1692.6 feet North and 490.4 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2813, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 82° 07' 70.9 feet along road (30 feet wide), to a spike set in concrete;
2. 169° 51' 124.8 feet along Government Land to a pipe set in concrete;
3. 271° 51' 77.0 feet along L.C.A. 9502 to Kekau to a spike set in concrete;
4. 352° 07' 111.7 feet along Lot 14, to the point of beginning.
