Beginning at \dagger on set stone on the West side of Palolo Valley 50 Foot Road and at the Northeast corner of this lot, the true azimuth and distance from said marked stone to Government Survey Trig. Station "Makanui" being $190^{\circ} 15' 30''$ 419.7 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2293, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $49^{\circ} 00'$ 374.7 feet along the West side of Palolo Valley Road to \dagger on set stone;
2. $123^{\circ} 23'$ 152.7 feet along kuauna along L.C.A. 3415B to Kaahui to \dagger on set stone;
3. $177^{\circ} 54'$ 92.4 feet along kuauna along L.C.A. 3415B to Kaahui to fence corner;
4. $249^{\circ} 20'$ 26.4 feet along L.C.A. 3415B to Kaahui to \dagger on set stone;
5. $229^{\circ} 55'$ 344.0 feet along L.C.A. 3415B to Kaahui;
6. $277^{\circ} 50'$ 82.0 feet along the Southwest side of Palolo Valley Road;
7. Thence along the Southwest side of Palolo Valley Road, on a curve to the right having a radius of 86 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being: $343^{\circ} 30'$ 156.5 feet to the point of beginning.
