Application of Kaailehua

Kamaili, Puna, Hawaii.

Re-numbered Lot 16 of the Keauohana-Kehena-Keekee-Kamaili Homesteads.

Beginning at the West corner of this lot on 40 foot road, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kaliu" being 13108.2 feet <sup>South</sup> and 356.8 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2075, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $219^{\circ} 15'$  1122.4 feet along Grant 1023, Apana 2 to Makuakane and Lot 19;
2.  $314^{\circ} 30'$  470.0 feet along Government Land;
3.  $3^{\circ} 50'$  575.0 feet along Government Land;
4.  $9^{\circ} 55'$  363.0 feet along Government Land;
5.  $112^{\circ} 32'$  1022.0 feet along land of Kukuihala to the point of beginning.
