Beginning at an iron pipe at the Northwest corner of this lot and the Northeast corner of Lot 18, Block 602, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 9967.7 feet South and 9598.5 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2600, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 265° 40' 242.0 feet along Lot 19, Block 602, to an iron pipe;
2. 355° 40' 180.0 feet along the West side of Volcano Road to an iron pipe;
3. 85° 40' 242.0 feet along Lot 15, Block 602, to an iron pipe;
4. 175° 40' 180.0 feet along Lot 18, Block 602, to the point of beginning.
