Palolo Homesteads,
Pukele, Palolo Valley, Kona, Oahu.

Beginning at \dagger on large solid rock on the North side of Palolo Valley 50 Foot Road at the South corner of this lot and the Southwest corner of Lot 14, the true azimuth and distance from said marked rock to Government Survey Trig. Station "Makanui" being $235^{\circ} 21'$ 332.5 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2293, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $151^{\circ} 00'$ 27.0 feet along the East side of Palolo Valley Road;
2. $172^{\circ} 24'$ 132.0 feet along the East side of Palolo Valley Road;
3. $183^{\circ} 24'$ 228.0 feet along the East side of Palolo Valley Road;
4. $200^{\circ} 10'$ 43.0 feet along the East side of Palolo Valley Road;
5. $215^{\circ} 24'$ 210.0 feet along the East side of Palolo Valley Road;
6. Thence still along the East side of Palolo Valley Road, on a curve to the left having a radius of 128 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being: $167^{\circ} 30'$ 192.0 feet;
7. Thence up the center of the Pukele Stream along L.C.A. 10169 to Mahoe, the direct azimuth and distance being: $203^{\circ} 35'$ 391.0 feet;
8. $104^{\circ} 00'$ 219.4 feet along L.C.A. 10169 to Mahoe and Lot 14, Palolo Homestead Lease Lots to \dagger on set stone;
9. $209^{\circ} 35'$ 117.5 feet along land of Wailupe to a chisel driven in the ground;

10. 279° 15' 1086.0 feet along Lot 18, down pali passing over \dagger on large rock in Pukele Stream and up pali to "Peak" Trig. Station on top of ridge between Pukele and Waiomao; from which the true azimuth and distance to "Rocky Hollow" Trig. Station is 201° 18' 1263.0 feet;
11. 32° 54' 371.0 feet along top of ridge between Pukele and Waiomao along Lot 7;
12. 35° 14' 181.0 feet along top of ridge between Pukele and Waiomao along Lot 6 to \dagger on rock;
13. 50° 26' 744.0 feet down spur along Lot 14 to "Makanui" Trig. Station (marked by \triangle on solid rock); from which the true azimuth and distance to "Paina 2" Trig. Station is 350° 28' 30" 2198.9 feet and to "Waiomao" Trig. Station is 28° 43' 30" 1921.6 feet;
14. 55° 21' 332.5 feet down spur along Lot 14 to the point of beginning.

Excepting and reserving therefrom L.C.A. 3738B, Apana 2 to Kolihana, L.C.A. 1912, Apana 2 to Malo, and portions of L.C.Awards 1845 to Lice and 3415B to Kaahui, and that portion of the 20 Foot Homestead Road, within this lot, leaving a net area of 15.8 ACRES.
