Description of survey of the amended
South Boundary Line of Lots 18 and 19 of the
Pupukea-Paumalu Homesteads,
Koolauloa, Oahu.

Beginning at a pipe at fence at the Southeast corner of Lot 17 and the Southwest corner of Lot 18 of the Pupukea-Paumalu Homesteads, and on the edge of pali of Kauwalau Gulch, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Pupukea" being 7154.4 feet South and 3312.3 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2252, and running by true azimuths:-

23. 306° 10' 633.5 feet to a pipe;
24. 207° 45' 164.5 feet along fence to corner of fences on the boundary of Lot 19 and the Forest Reservation, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Pupukea" being 5813.6 feet South and 7303.7 feet East.
