Being a portion of Lot 15, Grant 6174 to William Henry of the Keaahala Homesteads, a portion of L.C.A. 5822 to Koolau, and a portion of L.C.A. 5820:2 to Kapuniaia, situated at Kaneohe, Oahu.

Beginning at a 3/4" galvanized iron pipe at the South-West corner of this piece, on the East side of a road, the same being the North-West corner of Lot 19, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "Coolidge", being 747.4 feet South, and 1075.2 feet West, and running by true azimuths from the above described initial point:

1. 176° 00' 105.0 feet along the East side of a 20 foot road, to a pipe;
2. 266° 00' 163.0 feet along Lot 17 to a pipe;
3. 356° 00' 105.0 feet along Lot 36-D to a pipe;
4. 86° 00' 163.0 feet along Lot 19 to the point of beginning, and containing an area of 17,115 square feet.
