Being a Portion of the Government Land of Waiakea.

Beginning at a spike at the South corner of this lot, the East corner of Lot 19 and on the Northwest side of Keaukaha Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Keokea No. 2" being 1417.83 feet South and 157.71 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map 2655, and running by azimuths measured clockwise from true South:-

1. 130° 59' 30" 549.40 feet along Lot 19 to a spike;
2. 266° 02' 85.00 feet along government land to a spike;
3. 311° 45' 36.00 feet along same to a spike;
4. 242° 40' 33.00 feet along same to a spike;
5. 174° 40' 31.00 feet along same to a spike;
6. 240° 35' 61.38 feet along same to a spike;
7. 320° 30' 425.86 feet along government land (General Lease 1441 to K.Kawasaki and T.R. Saiki) to a spike;
8. 28° 00' 101.75 feet along the Northwest side of Keaukaha Road to the point of beginning.
