Being a portion of the Government Land of Keonepoko Iki

Beginning at a spike and stonepile at the north corner of this lot, the east corner of Lot 17, and on the southwest side of the Government Main Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Reference Station "Village Flag" (marked by a 2" pipe in concrete) being 348.80 feet North and 315.26 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map 2370, and running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:-

1. 323° 23' 50.0 feet along the southwest side of the Government Main Road to a spike and stonepile;
2. 53° 23' 200.0 feet along Lot 19 to a spike and stonepile;
3. 143° 23' 50.0 feet along the northeast side of Road Reserve to a spike and stonepile;
4. 233° 23' 200.0 feet along Lot 17 to the point of beginning.
