Beginning at the East corner of this lot and the North corner of Lot 18B, the coordinates of which point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kaliu" are 14259.6 feet South and 965.6 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2075, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $56^{\circ} 05'$  1536.6 feet along Lot 18B;
2.  $157^{\circ} 25'$  1477.5 feet along government land;
3.  $219^{\circ} 15'$  788.5 feet along government land;
4.  $309^{\circ} 45'$  1747.5 feet along the Southwest side of a 40 foot road reserve to the point of beginning.
