

Beginning at an iron pipe at the Southeast corner of this lot and the Northeast corner of Lot 20, Block 402, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 7734.1 feet South and 9429.2 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2600, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 85° 40' 242.0 feet along Lot 20, Block 402, to an iron pipe;
2. Thence along the East side of "Road 1 West" on a curve to the left, having a radius of 701.8 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being: 171° 05' 112.2 feet to an iron pipe;
3. 256° 30' 242.0 feet along Lot 18, Block 402 to an iron pipe;
4. 351° 05' 150.8 feet along Lot 2, Block 402, to the point of beginning.
