Being a portion of Lot 15, Grant 6174 to William Henry of the Keaahala Homesteads, a portion of L.C.A. 5820:2 Kapuniai, all of L.C.A. 5081:1 to Kuiai and a portion of L.C.A. 4235:1 to Kane, situated at Kaneohe, Oahu.

Beginning at a 3/4" galvanized iron pipe at the North-West corner of this lot, on the East side of a 20 foot road, the same being the South-West corner of Lot 18, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "Coolidge" being, 747.4 feet South, 1075.2 feet West, and running by true azimuths from the above described initial point:

1. 266° 00' 163.0 feet along Lot 18 to a pipe;
2. 356° 00' 153.1 feet along Lot 36-D to a pipe;
3. 82° 30' 163.3 feet along Lot 36-D and along Spring Reserve President Executive Order No. 2075 to a pipe;
4. 176° 00' 163.1 feet along Spring Reserve President Executive Order No. 2075 and along the East side of a 20 foot road to the point of beginning and containing an area of 25,770 square feet.
