Kaniahiku, Puna, Hawaii

Being a portion of the Government Land of Kaniahiku

Beginning at the southwest corner of this lot, the southeast corner of Lot 3, Block 1, Kaniahiku Village Site, and on the north side of the 50-Foot Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "HONUULA" being 2319.50 feet North and 12512.49 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map H.S.S. Plat 819, thence running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:-

1. 182° 31' 121.54 feet along Lot 3, Block 1, Kaniahiku Village Site;
2. 272° 31' 91.20 feet along Lot 1, Block 1, Kaniahiku Village Site;
3. 2° 31' 91.54 feet along the west side of the 50-Foot Road;
4. Thence along the northwesterly side of the 50-Foot Road, on a curve to the right with a radius of 30.00 feet, the chord azimuth and distance being 47° 31' 42.43 feet;
5. 92° 31' 61.20 feet along the north side of the 50-Foot Road to the point of beginning and containing an Area of 0.25 Acre.
