Station "Rocky Hollow" being $338^{\circ} 07' 30''$ 1191.2 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2293, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $116^{\circ} 06'$ 611.0 feet along Lot 19 to koa tree;
2. ~~$215^{\circ} 25'$ 1261.0~~ ^{$215^{\circ} 58'$ 1263.5} feet along Forest Reserve to ~~on set stone~~ ^{a pipe};
3. $343^{\circ} 57'$ 379.0 feet along land of Kekio; to ~~on~~ large solid rock;
4. ~~$7^{\circ} 10'$ 403.0~~ ^{$6^{\circ} 08'$ 410.0} feet along land of Kekio; ^{to a pipe};
5. $29^{\circ} 04'$ 387.0 feet along land of Kekio; ^{to a pipe}
6. $20^{\circ} 05'$ 193.0 feet along land of Kekio to the point of beginning.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a Right-of-Way, 20 feet wide, through this lot to the Forest Reserve, leaving a net area of 11.6 ACRES.
