Beginning at a red-wood post at the South corner of this lot, the East corner of Lot 207 and on the Northwest side of Mailiilii Road, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig Station "Paheehee Uka" being 3992.4 feet South and 493.1 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2359, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 129° 18' 1052.2 feet along Lot 207 to a red-wood post;
2. 219° 18' 209.0 feet along government land to a + on rock;
3. 194° 30' 242.4 feet along government land to a + on rock;
4. 309° 18' 1153.9 feet along Lots 202, 203, 204 and 205 to a red-wood post;
5. 39° 18' 429.0 feet along Mailiilii Road to the point of beginning.

Area 10-62/100 Acres.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 40 feet wide across this lot for the storm ditch, said right-of-way containing an area of 59/100 Acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 10-03/100 ACRES.
