Beginning at a red-wood post at the East corner of this lot, the South corner of Lot 207 and on the Northwest side of Mailiilii Road, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Paheehee Uka" being 4325.2 feet South and 220.7 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2359, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 39° 18' 150.4 feet along Mailiilii Road to a red-wood post;
2. 79° 38' 460.0 feet along Waianae Co. railroad right-of-way to a red-wood post;
3. 129° 18' 662.3 feet along government land to a + on rock;
4. 219° 18' 176.0 feet along government land to a + on rock;
5. 203° 28' 338.0 feet along government land to a + on rock;
6. 309° 18' 1052.2 feet along Lot 207 to the point of beginning.

Area 10-57/100 Acres.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 40 feet wide across this lot for the storm ditch, said right-of-way containing an area of 46/100 Acres, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 10-11/100 ACRES.
