Beginning at a red-wood post at the North corner of this lot the West corner of Lot 210 and on the Southeast side of Mailiilii Road, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Paheehē Uka" being 4094.2 feet South and 473.5 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2359, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 309° 18' 670.0 feet along Lot 210 to a red-wood post;
2. 67° 20' 168.0 feet along right-of-way for the storm ditch to a red-wood post;
3. 120° 25' 157.2 feet along right-of-way for the storm ditch to a red-wood post;
4. 93° 08' 303.2 feet along right-of-way for the storm ditch to a red-wood post;
5. 88° 29' 289.5 feet along right-of-way for the storm ditch to a red-wood post;
6. 219° 18' 488.4 feet along Mailiilii Road to the point of beginning.

Area 3-59/100 Acres.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 20 feet wide across this lot for the Waianae Co. railroad, said right-of-way containing an area of 29/100 acre. LEAVING A NET AREA OF 3-30/100 ACRES
