Beginning at a spike and pile of stones at the North corner of this lot, the East corner of Lot 20 and on the Southwest side of Government Main Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to "Village Flag" Trig. Station being 214.2 feet North and 215.1 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No.2370, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 323° 23' 75.0 feet along Government Main Road to a spike and pile of stones;
2. 53° 23' 200.0 feet along Lot 22 to a spike and pile of stones;
3. 143° 23' 75.0 feet along road reserve to a spike and pile of stones;
4. 233° 23' 200.0 feet along Lot 20 to the point of beginning.
