PAHOA VILLAGE LOTS

Lot 21

Keonepoko Iki, Puna, Hawaii

Being a portion of the Government Land of Keonepoko Iki

Beginning at a spike and stonepile at the north corner of this lot, the east corner of Lot 20, Pahoa Village Lots, and on the southwest side of Puna Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Reference Station "VILLAGE FLAG" (marked by a 2-inch pipe in concrete) being 213.95 feet North and 215.06 feet West, and the coordinates of said Reference Station "VILLAGE FLAG" referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "PAHOA" being 1527.1 feet South and 1467.8 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map 2370, thence running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:-

1. 323° 23' 75.00 feet along the southwest side of Puna Road to a spike and stonepile;
2. 53° 23' 200.00 feet along Grant 13278 to Kahaipo Nuhi Wright (Lot 22, Pahoa Village Lots), to a spike and stonepile;
3. 143° 23' 75.00 feet along the northeast side of Road Reserve to a spike and stonepile;
4. 233° 23' 200.00 feet along Lot 20, Pahoa Village Lots, to the point of beginning and containing an Area of 15,000 Square Feet.
