Station "Paheehae Uka" being 4088.7 feet South and 1399.7 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2359, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 28° 33' 297.0 feet along right-of-way for the storm ditch to a red-wood post;
2. 129° 18' 774.6 feet along Lot 210 to a red-wood post;
3. 219° 18' 291.8 feet along Mailiilii Road to a red-wood post;
4. 309° 18' 719.2 feet along Lot 212 to the point of beginning.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 20 feet wide across this lot for the Waianae Co. railroad, said right-of-way containing an area of 20/100 acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 4-80/100 ACRES.
