Beginning at a point on the mauka line of Wright Street, said point being 108.2 feet Northwest from an iron pin at the North corner of Waiaka and Wright Streets, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2126, and running by true bearings:-

1. N $44^{\circ} 32' 30''$ W 50.0 feet along mauka line of Wright Street; thence,
2. N $45^{\circ} 27' 30''$ E 100.0 feet along Lot 24; thence,
3. S $44^{\circ} 32' 30''$ E 50.0 feet along L.C.A. 5937, Ap. 7, Paukuwahie; thence,
4. S $45^{\circ} 27' 30''$ W 100.0 feet along Lots ~~22~~²² and ~~21~~²¹ to initial point.
