Beginning at a spike and pile of stones at the North corner of this lot, the East corner of Lot 24, and on the Southwest side of Government Main Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to "Village Flag" Trig. Station being <sup>21.32</sup>~~21.5~~ feet North and 71.90 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2370, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 323° 23' 80.0 feet along Government Main Road to  $\Delta$  on mauka side of pahoehoe mound;
2. 45° 00' 202.2 feet along road reserve to spike and pile of stones;
3. 143° 23' 109.5 feet along road reserve to spike and pile of stones;
4. 233° 23' 200.0 feet along Lot 24 to the point of beginning.
