Beginning at the North corner of this lot which is about midway on the West line of L. C. A. 8341:2 to Kahunahana, the coordinates of said corner referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "North Base" being 1293.7 feet South and 110.0 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2000 and running by true azimuths:-

1. 77° 55' 109.0 feet along Lot 25 to a stake;
2. 348° 50' 504.0 feet along Lot 25 and L. C. A. 8171:2 to Hoopalahee;
3. 254° 10' 138.0 feet along L. C. A. 4285 to Kahema;
4. 163° 25' 185.0 feet along L. C. A. 8164C:2 to Kanealii;
5. 234° 05' 116.0 feet along L. C. A. 8164C:2 to Kanealii;
6. 260° 10' 34.0 feet along L. C. A. 8338:1 to Kealoha;
7. 166° 20' 90.0 feet along L. C. A. 8411:1 to Kaunele;
8. 73° 55' 145.0 feet along L. C. A. 8341:2 to Kahunahana;
9. 167° 55' 183.0 feet along L. C. A. 8341:2 to Kahunahana to the point of beginning.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom a right-of-way 40 feet wide across this lot for the Koolau Railway, said right-of-way containing an area of 36/100 acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 1-35/100 ACRES.
