KANIAHIKU HOUSE LOTS EXTENSION

Kaniahiku, Puna, Hawaii, T. H.

Being portion of the Government Land of Kaniahiku.

Beginning at a  $\frac{3}{4}$  inch pipe at the northwest corner of this lot, the southwest corner of Lot 25, Kaniahiku House Lots Extension, and on the east side of 50-Foot Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "PAHOA" being 2155.68 feet South and 8275.85 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered H.T.S. Plat 816-A, thence running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:-

1. 286° 30'      470.22 feet along Lot 25, Kaniahiku House Lots Extension to a  $\frac{3}{4}$  inch pipe;
2. 16° 30'      240.00 feet along Lot 24, Kaniahiku House Lots Extension to a  $\frac{3}{4}$  inch pipe;
3. 106° 30'     470.22 feet along Lot 24, Kaniahiku House Lots Extension to a  $\frac{3}{4}$  inch pipe;
4. 196° 30'     240.00 feet along the east side of 50-Foot Road to the point of beginning and containing an Area of 2.591 Acres.
