Being portion of the Government (Crown) Land of Hauula and portion of Grant 8924 to Henry Freitas conveyed to the Territory of Hawaii by deed dated April 30, 1926 and recorded in Liber 817, page 375.

Beginning at a pipe at the west corner of this lot, the south corner of Lot 27-E (Grant 8924 to Henry Freitas) and on the northeast side of Homestead Road (40 feet wide), the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "Kaipapau" being 4695.58 feet South and 4360.24 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map 2721, and running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:-

1. 211° 17' 30" 142.73 feet to a pipe;
2. 241° 03' 11.84 feet to a pipe;
3. 170° 34' 4.94 feet to a pipe on south side of ditch right-of-way;
4. 254° 18' 7.65 feet along the south side of ditch right-of-way;
5. 266° 50' 45.37 feet along same;
6. 263° 10' 188.55 feet along same;
7. 275° 30' 5.08 feet along same to a pipe;
8. 347° 35' 82.39 feet along Lot 1-A, Hauula Homestead Water Lots to a pipe;
9. 67° 50' 180.00 feet along L.C. Award 8313 Apana 3 to Kamoiliili to a pipe;
