Beginning at an iron bolt at the West corner of this lot, on boundary of the Waianae Forest Reserve, the coordinates of said iron-referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kuwale" being: 237.0 feet North and 6650.0 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2501, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 247° 05' 333.8 feet along Waianae Forest Reserve to a red-wood post;
2. 316° 13' 1791.1 feet along Lot 34 crossing ditch and 4" water pipe rights-of-way;
3. 49° 38' 304.8 feet along government road to a stake;
4. 36° 31' 135.2 feet along government road to a stake;
5. 69° 13' 207.9 feet along government road to a red-wood post;
6. 75° 07' 355.3 feet along government road to a red-wood post;
7. 38° 49' 200.2 feet along government road to a red-wood post;
8. 151° 36' 855.1 feet along flume right-of-way to a pipe;
9. 190° 22' 730.6 feet along flume right-of-way to a pipe;
10. 137° 27' 434.2 feet along flume right-of-way to the point of beginning.

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Area 31-60/100 Acres.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 6 feet wide across this lot for the Waianae Co. 4" Water Pipe, said right-of-way containing an area of 13/100 acre; also excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 10 feet wide across this lot for the Waianae Co. ditch, said right-of-way containing an area of 22/100 Acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 31-25/100 ACRES.
