Beginning at an iron pipe at the East corner of this lot and on the West side of 30 Foot Homestead Road, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Coolidge" being 6297.8 feet South and 3691.9 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2562, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 70° 00' 1391.0 feet along Lot 34 to an iron pipe near the edge of the stream;
2. Thence along near the edge of the stream to an iron pipe, the direct azimuth and distance being:-
170° 08' 404.7 feet;
3. 250° 00' 1285.0 feet along Lot 32 to an iron pipe;
4. 335° 00' 400.0 feet along Homestead Road to the point of beginning.
Area 13-24/100 Acres.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom a right-of-way 10 feet wide for the ditch across this lot, said right-of-way containing an area of 9/100 acre: LEAVING A NET AREA OF 13-15/100 ACRES.
