Beginning at a stake at the West corner of this lot and the North corner Lot 33 and on the South side of Beretania Avenue, the true azimuth and distance being $74^{\circ} 06'$ 156.8 feet to an iron bolt marking the East corner of Beretania Avenue and Church Lane, and the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kamoiliili" are 236.2 feet South and 249.7 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2126, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $254^{\circ} 06'$ 50.0 feet along Beretania Avenue to a stake;
2. $344^{\circ} 06'$ 129.5 feet along Lot 35 to a stake;
3. $106^{\circ} 10'$ 59.0 feet along Lot 40 to a stake;
4. $164^{\circ} 06'$ 98.2 feet along Lot 33 to the point of beginning.
