Beginning at the West corner of this lot, on the South side of Waianuenue Street and the East side of the Hilo Sugar Company's flume right-of-way, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. 1. 236° 48' 162.0 feet along South side of Waianuenue Street;

3. 52° 49' 245.83 feet along North side of Punahoa Street;
4. 157° 22' 453.95 feet along East boundary of Hilo Sugar Company's flume right-of-way to the point of beginning.
