Beginning at a stake at the West corner of this lot and the East corner of Lot 39 and on the North side of Church Lane, the true azimuth and distance being $138^{\circ} 14'$ 256.8 feet to an iron bolt marking the East corner of Beretania Avenue and Church Lane, and the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kamoiliili" are 470.7 feet South and 270.0 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2126, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $228^{\circ} 14'$ 160.8 feet along Lot 39 to a stake;
2. $295^{\circ} 29'$ 30.4 feet along Lot 36 to a stake;
3. $323^{\circ} 19' 30''$ 19.9 feet along L.C.A. 1525 to Kuaana to a stake;
4. $47^{\circ} 30' 30''$ 170.8 feet along 10 Foot Lane to a stake;
5. $138^{\circ} 14'$ 50.0 feet along Church Lane to the point of beginning.
