Being a portion of the Government Land of Kaniahiku

Beginning at the southwest corner of this lot, the south-east corner of Lot 5, Block 1, Kaniahiku Village Site, and on the north side of the 50-Foot Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "HONUULA" being 2327.39 feet North and 12691.92 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map H.S.S. Plat 819, thence running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:-

- 1. 182° 31' 242.00 feet along Lot 5, Block 1, Kaniahiku Village Site;
- 2. 272° 31' 90.00 feet along Nanawale Forest Reserve, Part 3 (Executive Order 1666);
- 3. 2° 31' 242.00 feet along Lots 1 and 3, Block 1, Kaniahiku Village Site;
- 4. 92° 31' 90.00 feet along the north side of the 50-Foot Road to the point of beginning and containing an Area of 0.50 Acre.
