Beginning at a stake at the Southeast corner of this lot and the Northeast corner of Lot 39 and on the West side of Kulioou Road, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Koko Head" being: 8738.3 feet North and 6719.2 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2520, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $174^{\circ} 08'$ 189.2 feet along West side of Kulioou Road to a stake;
2. $175^{\circ} 27'$ 360.7 feet along West side of Kulioou Road to a stake;
3. $85^{\circ} 27'$ 341.2 feet along Lot 44 to a stake;
4. $356^{\circ} 37'$ 550.0 feet along the land of Kulioou 2nd to a stake;
5. $265^{\circ} 27'$ 356.5 feet along Lot 39 to the point of beginning.
