Beginning at a pipe at the South corner of this lot, and the Northeast corner of Waianuenue and Kaahumanu Streets, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 572.43 feet South and 9149.98 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2658, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 128° 26' 176.81 feet along the Northeast side of Kaahumanu Street to a pipe;
2. 230° 14' 152.90 feet along Lot 41 to a pipe;
3. 320° 14' 187.58 feet along Lot 39 to a pipe;
4. 57° 19' 117.66 feet along North side of Waianuenue Street to the point of beginning.
