Beginning at a pipe on the South side of this lot at angle of 40 foot roads, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Koko Head" being: 9830.1 feet North and 6770.3 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2520, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 355° 27' 41.75 feet along East side of Kuliouou Road to a stake;
2. 282° 04' 408.0 feet along Government Reserve and Lot 43 to a stake
3. 265° 27' 890.5 feet along Lot 43 to a stake;
4. 182° 34' 450.0 feet along fence along top of ridge to a stake;
5. 85° 27' 1663.0 feet along Lot 46 to a stake;
6. 356° 37' 190.8 feet along East side of Kuliouou Road to a stake;
7. 282° 04' 343.4 feet along North side of Kuliouou Road to the point of beginning.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 40 feet wide across this lot for the ditch, said right-of-way containing an area of 61/100 acre, LEAVING A NET AREA classified as follows:
