3. 272° 31' 270.00 feet along Nanawale Forest Reserve, Part 3 (Executive Order 1666);
4. 2° 31' 242.00 feet along Lot 4, Block 1, Kaniahiku Village Site, to the point of beginning and containing an Area of 1.50 Acres.
