Beginning at an iron pipe at the Southwest corner of this lot and the Southeast corner of Lot 515-B, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 10120.6 feet South and 4666.0 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2600, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 175° 40' 1800.0 feet along Lot 515-B to an iron pipe;
2. 265° 40' 484.0 feet along South side of "Road 8" to an iron pipe;
3. 355° 40' 1800.0 feet along Lot 514-B to an iron pipe;
4. 85° 40' 484.0 feet along Lot 615-A to the point of beginning.
