Beginning at an iron pipe at a post marked LV-LVI at the West corner of this lot and the South corner of Lot 55 Waikaumalo-Maulua Homesteads (Grant 5494 to John Kekoi) on the Northeast side of 60 foot roadway, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Puu Ohai" being 10313.3 feet South and 10111.4 West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2201, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 232° 11' 2110.8 feet along Lot 55 Waikaumalo-Maulua Homesteads to an iron pipe and post marked LV-LVI;
2. 327° 22' 214.0 feet along 60 foot road reservation;
3. 263° 22' 135.0 feet along 60 foot road reservation;
4. 262° 40' 104.0 feet along 60 foot road reservation;
5. 288° 20' 217.0 feet along 60 foot road reservation;
6. 316° 27' 127.0 feet along 60 foot road reservation;
7. 294° 35' 116.0 feet along 60 foot road reservation;
8. 23° 55' 195.0 feet along 60 foot road reservation;
9. 48° 50' 30" 2504.4 feet along Lot 56A Waikaumalo-Maulua Homesteads;
10. 146° 00' 231.0 feet along 60 foot road reservation;
11. 159° 15' 438.0 feet along 60 foot road reservation;
12. 149° 59' 337.0 feet along 60 foot road reservation to the point of beginning.
