Beginning at an iron pipe at the Southwest corner of this lot and the Southeast corner of Lot 611-B, on the North side of "Road 10", the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 11659.8 feet South and 8705.8 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2600, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $175^{\circ} 40'$  1095.0 feet along Lot 611-B to an iron pipe;
2.  $194^{\circ} 55'$  324.1 feet along railroad reserve to an iron pipe;
3.  $184^{\circ} 35'$  242.7 feet along same to an iron pipe;
4.  $176^{\circ} 05'$  114.9 feet along same to an iron pipe;
5.  $170^{\circ} 09'$  64.5 feet along same to an iron pipe;
6.  $265^{\circ} 40'$  345.0 feet along 20 ft. road leading to Camp 3, to an iron pipe;
7.  $355^{\circ} 40'$  1820.0 feet along Lots 1 to 10 inclusive, Block 603, to an iron pipe;
8.  $85^{\circ} 40'$  484.0 feet along North side of "Road 10" to the point of beginning.
