
Beginning at an iron pipe at the Northwest corner of this lot and the Northeast corner of Lot 711-B, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 11699.7 feet South and 8708.8 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2600, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 265° 40' 484.0 feet along the South side of "Road 10" to an iron pipe;
2. 355° 40' 1800.0 feet along Lots 1 to 10 inclusive, Block 703, to an iron pipe;
3. 85° 40' 484.0 feet along Lot 804-A to an iron pipe;
4. 175° 40' 1800.0 feet along Lot 711-B to the point of beginning.

Area 20 Acres.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 20 feet wide for the railroad across this lot, said right-of-way containing an Area of  $\frac{84}{100}$  Acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF  $\frac{19-16}{100}$  ACRES.
