
Beginning at an iron pipe at the Northeast corner of this lot and the Northwest corner of Lot 715-A, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 11995.0 feet South and 4808.0 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2600, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 355° 40' 1800.0 feet along Lot 715-A to an iron pipe;
2. 85° 40' 484.0 feet along Lot 808-B, to an iron pipe;
3. 175° 40' 1800.0 feet along Lot 716-A to an iron pipe;
4. 265° 40' 484.0 feet along South side of "Road 10" to the point of beginning.

AREA 20 ACRES.

Excepting and reserving therefrom rights-of-way 40 feet wide for the road (66/100 Acre) and railroads (42/100 Acre) across this lot, being respectively 20 feet and 10 feet wide, said rights-of-way containing an Area of 1-08/100 Acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 18-92/100 ACRES.
