Beginning at the Northeast corner of this lot and the Northwest corner of Lot 717-A, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 12141.2 feet South and 2877.5 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2600, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 355° 40' 1705.2 feet along Lot 717-A to an iron pipe;
2. 57° 31' 235.9 feet along camp site No. 4, Section B, to a stake;
3. 327° 31' 135.3 feet along same to a stake;
4. 56° 50' 388.2 feet along North side of "Road A" to an iron pipe;
5. 175° 40' 2122.9 feet along East side of "Road 3 West" to an iron pipe;
6. 265° 40' 484.0 feet along South side of "Road 10" to the point of beginning.
