Beginning at an iron pipe at the Northwest corner of this lot, the Northeast corner of Lot 719 and on the South side of "Road 10", the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 12254.4 feet South and 1389.8 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2650, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 265° 40' 968.0 feet along the South side of "Road 10" to an iron pipe;
2. 355° 40' 1200.0 feet along the West side of "Road 3 West", to an iron pipe;
3. 85° 40' 968.0 feet along Lot 812-B to an iron pipe;
4. 175° 40' 1200.0 feet along Lot 719 to the point of beginning.

AREA 26-67/100 ACRES.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 20 feet wide for the railroad across this lot, said right-of-way containing an Area of 13/100 Acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 26-54/100 ACRES.
