Beginning at an iron pipe at the Northeast corner of this lot, the Northwest corner of Lot 720 and on the South side of "Road 10", the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 12400.7 feet South and 540.7 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2650, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 355° 40' 1800.0 feet along Lot 720 to an iron pipe;
2. 85° 40' 968.0 feet along Lot 815 to an iron pipe;
3. 175° 40' 1800.0 feet along Lot 722 to an iron pipe;
4. 265° 40' 968.0 feet along the South side of "Road 10" to the point of beginning.

AREA 40 ACRES.

Excepting and reserving therefrom the Government Survey Trig. Station "Wilson" and a lot 50 feet square surrounding same, (Area 06/100 Acre), together with the right to enter upon said lot and to occupy said Trig. Station.

Also, excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 20 feet wide for the railroad across this lot, said right-of-way containing an Area of 46/100 Acre.
