Beginning at the Southeast corner of this lot and the Southwest corner of Lot 806-B, on the North side of "Road 12", the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 15515.1 feet South and 6530.8 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2600, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 85° 40' 484.0 feet along North side of "Road 12" to an iron pipe;
2. 175° 40' 1840.0 feet along Lot 807-B to an iron pipe;
3. 265° 40' 484.0 feet along Lot 714-A to an iron pipe;
4. 355° 40' 1840.0 feet along Lot 806-B to the point of beginning.

Area 20-44/100 Acres.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 20 feet wide for the railroad across this lot, said right-of-way containing an Area of 24/100 Acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 20-20/100 ACRES.
