Beginning at the Southwest corner of this lot and the Southeast corner of Lot 809, on the North side of "Road 12", the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 15661.4 feet South and 4600.4 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2600, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 175° 40' 1840.0 feet along Lot 809 to an iron pipe;
2. 265° 40' 484.0 feet along Lot 715-B to an iron pipe;
3. 355° 40' 1840.0 feet along Lot 808-A to an iron pipe;
4. 85° 40' 484.0 feet along the North side of "Road 12" to the point of beginning.

Area 20-44/100 Acres.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 20 feet wide for the railroad across this lot, said right-of-way containing an Area of 31/100 Acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 20-13/100 ACRES.
