Beginning at the Southwest corner of this lot and the Northwest corner of Lot 903, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 17200.6 feet South and 8640.2 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2600, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 175° 40' 900.0 feet along Lot 904 to an iron pipe;
2. 265° 40' 1828.3 feet along Lot 901 to an iron pipe;
3. 10° 04' 168.7 feet along West side of old Volcano Road to an iron spike;
4. 328° 25' 602.7 feet along same to an iron pipe;
5. 319° 52' 247.6 feet along same to an iron pipe;
6. 85° 40' 2207.2 feet along Lot 903 to the point of beginning.

Area 40-29/100 Acres.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 20 feet wide for the railroad across this lot, said right-of-way containing an Area of 87/100 Acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 39/42/100 ACRES.
