
Beginning at an iron pipe at the Southwest corner of this lot, on the East side of "Road 2 West", the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 17346.9 feet South and 6709.8 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2600, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 175° 40' 1800.0 feet along East side of "Road 2 West" to an iron pipe;
2. 265° 40' 968.0 feet along South side of "Road 12" to an iron pipe;
3. 355° 40' 1800.0 feet along Lot 904 to an iron pipe;
4. 85° 40' 968.0 feet along Lot 906 to the point of beginning.

Area 40 Acres.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 20 feet wide for the railroad across this lot, said right-of-way containing an Area of 40/100 Acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 39-60/100 ACRES.
