Station "Halai" being 17349.9 feet South and 6669.9 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2600, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 355° 40' 900.0 feet along West side of "Road 2 West" to an iron pipe;
2. 85° 40' 1936.0 feet along government land to an iron pipe;
3. 175° 40' 900.0 feet along Lot 912 to an iron pipe;
4. 265° 40' 1936.0 feet along Lots 908 and 907 to the point of beginning.
