Beginning at an iron pipe at the Southeast corner of this lot and the Southwest corner of Lot 910, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 17569.3 feet South and 3774.2 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2600, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 85° 40' 968.0 feet along Lot 912 to an iron pipe;
2. 175° 40' 1800.0 feet along East side of "Road 3 West" to an iron pipe;
3. 265° 40' 968.0 feet along South side of "Road 12" to an iron pipe;
4. 355° 40' 1800.0 feet along Lot 910 to the point of beginning.
